

- 31 people were baptized through immersion.
- Over 1,200 adults were involved in weekly Grow Groups for spiritual formation and monthly Cluster Groups for connection and care.
- Over 4,000 adults connected to St. Luke's ministries through stories shared in St. Luke's new magazine "Celebrate".
- 958 children attended VBS and camps this summer.
- St. Luke's partnered with three Title 1 schools that serve a total of 1,700 students.
- St. Luke's invested approximately \$65 per week per person to offer transformative ministry experiences. (Based on an average of 1,300 people in worship)


