Simplify:Â Jan. 4 to Jan. 25 (4 Weeks)

Exhausted. Overwhelmed. Overscheduled. Sound familiar? Today's velocity of life can consume and control us…until our breakneck pace begins to feel normal and expected. That's where the danger lies: When we spend our lives doing things that keep us busy but don't really matter, we sacrifice the things that do.



That 30-40 St. Lukers mentor hundreds of students at three elementary schools through Educational IMPACT. Â


That our "Celebrate!― magazine reaches 4,000 people. The magazine goes out quarterly, and tells the stories of ministry work St. Luke's is achieving.






That nearly 50% of our 2016 pledges came from new financial commitments. Â
