We are personally experiencing each day how "Love Wins" through Jesus in our household as we improve our communication, dependency, routine, and daily patience.

We frequently talk about Jesus and we actively pray with YuYu. The overall concept of Jesus, however, can be a bit complicated as YuYu is still learning English. We have found that experiences oftentimes communicate more than 1000 words for her. That is why we were so excited to attend St. Luke's EasterFest on Palm Sunday.

Yes, we were eager to see YuYu in her first massive Easter egg hunt (excited enough to have practice hunts at our house earlier that morning). We were also excited for her to pet the farm animals, play games, and get some great candy. More importantly, though, we couldn't wait for her to see the community of the Church in action. We knew that she would have the opportunity to feel the love of Jesus through the volunteers and inclusivity of this event. YuYu loved every moment of EasterFest and talked throughout the following week about the egg hunt, animals, and time with her friends. Her only disappointment came when we returned to church for Easter Sunday and her new horse friend wasn't there to greet her!

Our story of becoming a family may be unique, but our desire to have our daughter experience the love of Jesus is not. We are so thankful that the St. Luke's congregation sponsors events like EasterFest for the greater community.
