FINANCIAL UPDATE FROM BEN WITTEN

As we look at our church finances for the third quarter, first and foremost, I wanted to express a huge thank you as our giving through September is up 5% versus last year. This is an amazing expression of St. Luke's stewardship and a desire to follow God's calling to support the ministry and mission programs at our church. Our YTD giving is now at \$2,530,000 and our expenses are \$2,680,000, leaving us in a net deficit position of \$150,000. This is consistent with our budget expectations and we expect to close this deficit in the fourth quarter.






