St. Luke's CDC Security Procedures

- **Doors open at 8:55 a.m.**
- **Doors will be locked at 9:30 and stay locked until pick up times.**
- **Only one entry into CDC – main entry doors at Building “B”.**
- **During lock down time, you will need to press the triangle button to the right side of the door to have access to the CDC.**
