RESTORING HOPE THROUGH ORLANDO AND GLOBAL MISSION MINISTRIES

St. Luke's Missions collaborates with local organizations to empower families to break the cycle of poverty, particularly those who are facing family homelessness and hunger. Ways to get involved include serving with the Restoring Hope Housing and Nutrition Teams, Family Promise of Orlando, Habitat for Humanity, Educational IMPACT, Jobs Partnership, Shalom Prison Pen Pals and Inside Out Jail ministry. There are ways to serve individually, as a family, or with a small group.
