St. Luke's top priority is the health and safety of our staff, congregation, and community and we seek to create a healthy environment that attends to physical, mental, and spiritual needs. St. Luke's Children's and Youth Ministries are taking the following precautions for staff, volunteers, and participants:

- Face coverings required in common areas of St. Luke's buildings
- Temperature checks (those with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to participate) **Temperature:** _____ **Date:** _____
- Social distancing (minimum six feet apart)
- Frequent hand washing
- Individual water bottles
- Meet in small groups (maximum 15 participants/group in Phase 2)
- Meet for short periods of time (maximum 2 hours in Phase 2)

These precautions align with resources including the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) recommendations.

If you answer "Yes" for your child/youth to any of the following statements, please do not allow your child/youth to attend programming.

- Child/youth has had symptoms associated with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Child/youth has come into contact with someone who has tested positive or displayed symptoms associated with COVID-19 in the last 14 days

Please give careful consideration to the risk you are willing to assume if your child/youth:

- Regularly associates with people considered high risk by the CDC (e.g. someone 65 years or older or someone with underlying health conditions)
- Is immunocompromised or has any of the following health conditions:
