Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

Read 2 Timothy 1:3-7

- In this letter to Timothy, Paul refers to authentic faith. What does authentic faith mean to you? How do live out your authentic faith?
- What spiritual gifts do you see operating in Lois & Eunice?
- Think about the people who have been your faith models and mentors. Who has been a Lois and Eunice in your life (not necessarily a family member)?
- As you think about the people who have helped form you, consider those for whom you might be a model. At St. Luke's, we are striving to build a community of mentors who feed into one another's lives, especially into the lives of young people. Children and youth need 5 adults (other than their parents) to mentor and guide them along their faith journey. What children and youth do you know by name? For whom can you be a Lois & Eunice?
- As a group (or on your own), come up with a list of names of children and youth who might need a mentor, parent, or grandparent figure in their life. If you only know the name of the parent or where they sit in church or where they hang out in your neighborhood, that's a start! Pray for these young people and then come up with a plan to approach them and begin to foster a relationship with them.
