What are the qualifications for participating?

- High-school diploma or GED
- U.S. citizen or "right to work"
- Stable housing
- Ability to read/write in English
- No felonies in past 5 years
- No current drug/alcohol addictions
- Willingness to learn

How much does it cost?

LifeWorks training is free for participants.

What will I learn and experience?

- Create a professional résumé
- Create a comprehensive career plan
- Learn career search strategies
- Complete professional skills and abilities assessments
- Learn how to prepare for an interview
- Get mentored by a life/work coach... and more!

Do I have to be a Christian to attend?

No. The LifeWorks curriculum is based on biblical principles but does not require participants to belong to any particular faith.

Do you guarantee a job?

No jobs are guaranteed. However, almost 75% of participants get a job or enroll in skills training within 90 days of graduation. You'll attend a private Career & Interview Fair where you'll have exclusive access to employers that are hiring.

Do you provide money or scholarships to go back to school?

No. We do not pay tuition. However, we can connect you with community and education partners that provide tuition vouchers to eligible individuals for career and technical education (CTE). Currently, we are also able to award a stipend for living expenses to eligible participants while they are enrolled in CTE.

Do you provide childcare?

Childcare is not available at all locations. For the Spring 2024 semester, the only location hosting childcare is Summit Church.

Is there an age requirement?

You must be 18 years of age.
